International Refugee Rights Conference | Toronto, 7-9 June 2018 Funding request

In June 2018, the Canadian Council for Refugees will host an international conference designed to enhance effectiveness of NGOs in promoting the human rights of refugees and vulnerable migrants. The CCR is seeking funding to support the organization of this conference and the participation of keynote speakers and NGO representatives from around the world.

Context: At a time when refugee rights are under threat around the world, Canada offers something of a counterpoint in its approach to refugees. The Canadian Council for Refugees decided that an international conference in Canada could provide a constructive space for refugee rights NGOs from around the world to meet together, to learn from each other and to strategize together, while sharing positive Canadian approaches. (The CCR held a successful international conference in 2006.)

Funding needs: To make the conference a success, CCR needs some funding to help cover expenses related to the organization of the conference, most particularly:

- Travel subsidies for participants from the Global South;
- Travel expenses for key resource persons.

Why contribute? By supporting the conference, you will raise the profile of your organization, strengthen NGO networking globally and provide an opportunity for refugee rights advocates from less wealthy regions to learn and connect internationally.

Participants: CCR is inviting NGOs, academics, government officials, UNHCR, refugees and vulnerable migrants. We are committed to ensuring representation from the Global South. Most participants are expected to find their own funding, but funding is needed to support costs of some who could not otherwise attend.

Funding options

- Purchase a full or half page in the conference program. All proceeds will go to the travel fund.
- Sponsor a workshop or plenary session. Proceeds will go to the travel fund and other conference expenses.
- Make a general contribution to the conference expenses or to the travel fund specifically.
